

OFFICIAL RULES

The Union Station Foundation opportunity Drawing (the “Drawing”) for the chance to win a Custom Ornata Spitfire (the “Prize”) is being conducted by the Union Station Foundation, a non-profit **501(c)3** organization (“Charity”) under the laws of the State of Utah, with the drawing for the prize to be held at some event in the fall of 2019.

Contestants must be 18 years of age or older to participate.

There is no limit to the number of tickets one person may purchase.

Employees of the Charity and their spouses are not eligible to participate in the Drawing.

Odds of winning depend on the number of entrants, with each ticket having the same chance to win.

How to Enter; Ticket Limitation. Any Eligible Person may enter the Contest by obtaining an official numbered contest ticket (“Contest Ticket”) from the Charity during the Contest Period. Contest Tickets may be obtained in the following manner: (1) ordering online by visiting www.theunionstationfoundation.org and submitting an online ticket form; (2) by submitting intent to enter the drawing via regular mail with sufficient postage to the Charity at Union Station Foundation, Attn: Ornata Spitfire Drawing, 2501 Wall Ave, Ogden, Utah 84401; (3) by calling (801) 473-9465 to place an order over the phone or to request that an official entry form be mailed to you

The Charity will process each entry method in the same manner. After an order is processed, the Charity will either, at its option, send the Contestant his or her Contest Ticket Numbers by mail or email to the address provided by the Contestant. Contest Ticket Numbers may take up to six weeks to be received by mail or two weeks to be received by email.

Tickets may be purchased for a \$10 suggested donation. Donations may be made by cash, checks or money order (made payable to Union Station Foundation). Should the donor’s check not be honored by the bank, the ticket will become void and withdrawn from the drawing.

Tickets may be purchased by the following methods:

A ticket may be purchased without consideration or by paying an amount less than the suggested donation, by calling the number indicated above, or by emailing Michael@unionstationogden.org

By IRS declaration, ticket purchases for valuable prizes are not eligible for charitable tax deductions.

All ticket orders must be received with full payment no later than the last day of the contest, which is to be determined.

The Charity may decline to award the Prize if **less than \$65,000 is raised** through the sale of tickets for the Drawing.

The Charity may, at its election, delay the Drawing and extend ticket sales for a period of up to thirty (30) days beyond the date of the Drawing indicated above.

If the minimum funding reference above is not received by the time of the Drawing (as it may be extended), then all funds will be returned to those purchasing tickets.

The Prize has a market value of \$ 85,000

The winner of the Drawing (the “Winner”) will be determined by random drawing. The Winner need not be present to win. The Winner must claim the Prize within thirty (30) days following the date of the Drawing.

The Winner is solely responsible for all local, state and federal taxes, title, transfer fees, license duties, insurance and all expenses incurred in claiming the Prize. The Internal Revenue Service requires that any prizes valued at \$600 or more be issued a Form W-2G, and requires that the Winner pay 25% of the fair market value of the Prize, minus the amount of the wager, to the Charity, to remit to the IRS on the winner’s behalf. The Winner understands, acknowledges, and agrees that the Charity is not responsible for the quality and performance of the Prize and must release and discharge the Charity and any sponsors, as well as their employees, agents, officers, directors and legal representatives and assigns, from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, losses or expenses arising from or caused by the award of the Prize, including, but not limited to the payment of any and all taxes that are due.

The Charity, its Board of Directors and its agents assume no liability for lost or illegible tickets or entries, which will be deemed invalid and disqualified.

The decisions and rules of the Charity are final on all matters concerning the Drawing.

Void where prohibited by law.
